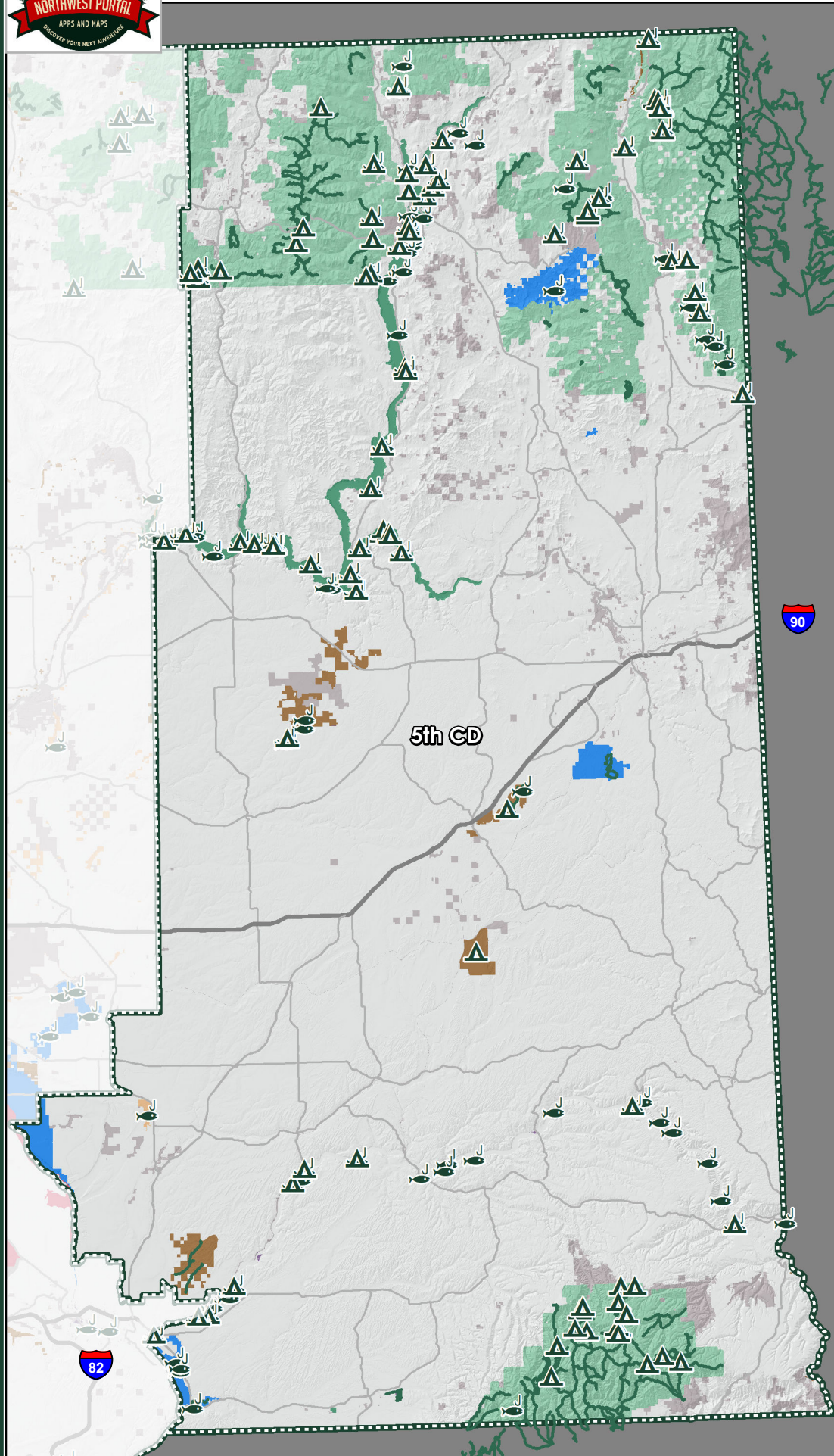
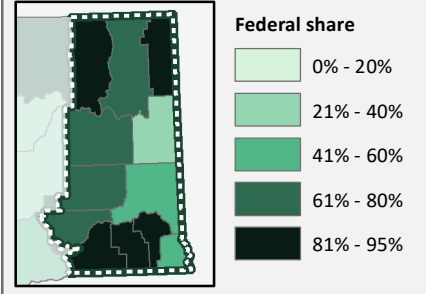




Federal Recreation: Washington's 5th Congressional District

Federal Recreation resources in the 5th Congressional District*

- 1,822,230 acres of federal recreation land, 81% of total.
- 936 miles of federal trails, 53% of trails.
- 130 water access sites, 20% of the total.
- 87 campgrounds, 68% of the total.
